



NCD ThinSTAR TIP: Protecting NCD ThinSTARs from Local Session Changes

Customer Requirement

A set of configured connections needs to be maintained for task-based workers.

Solution

The Configure tab in NCD ThinSTAR terminals Connection Manager can be disabled to control available connections.

Overview

A system administrator can create a set of connections needed by the company's task-based workers. The system administrator can disable the Configure tab in Connection Manager so the users cannot edit the connections, delete connections or add additional connections.

Additionally NCD ThinPATH Manager can be used to complete this work remotely and for all or a group of the NCD ThinSTAR terminals. The system administrator would first delete all current connections on the terminals, then update the terminals to the set of configured connections required and disable Connection Managers Configure tab

Benefit

A known set of configured connections can be maintained on the NCD ThinSTAR terminals. This can help guarantee connection availability and decrease administration needed.
