



NC Tip #6: Password Protected Setup

Customer Requirement

A systems administrator wants to be able to prevent users from accessing critical parameters in the NC900 local Setup menu. If a parameter is set incorrectly, the NC could be disabled.

Solution

NCBridge offers password protection for the NC900 local Setup menu. This feature allows a user to view the NC's current parameters while limiting the access to modify them.

Overview

A password may be specified in the NCBridge remote configuration file, xp.cnf, for each NC900 product. This password can then be saved into the NC900 NVRAM.

The Web-based Administrator also uses this password so as to prevent unauthorized access to the NC900's local Setup screen.

Benefit

Users are prevented from inadvertently modifying the crucial NC900 parameters inappropriately and disabling the device. The password protected Setup client reduces the demand placed on an IS staff; thus making the NC900 more cost effective than a PC.
