



NC Tip #10: ThinPATH Plus Support

Customer Requirement

A customer wants to be able to connect his PalmPilot to the NC900 serial port and synchronize his PalmPilot with his database on his Windows NT server.

Solution

NCBridge supports a Seriald client, which allows the NC900 to communicate with a Windows NT application via NCD ThinPATH Plus software.

Overview

Seriald is a local daemon that executes on the NC900. It provides the ability for a Windows NT application to transmit and receive data to and from a peripheral device connected to a remote NC900 serial port. Typical peripheral devices include printers, credit card readers and PalmPilots.

Configuration Hints

Note that a customer should test a particular peripheral device with the NC900 and ThinPATH Plus prior to purchasing the equipment. Some peripherals require protocols that are not compatible with ThinPATH Plus. Also, neither the parallel or audio features of ThinPATH Plus are supported on the NC900 at this time.

Benefit

Many customers want to be able to use peripheral devices with the NC900 and their Windows NT application without having to modify the application. Seriald and ThinPATH Plus provide that solution.
